## Proverbs for Pandemics August 2, 2020

**Advice**—Listen to advice/counsel/rebuke/correction/discipline Whoever loves discipline loves knowledge, but whoever hates correction is stupid (12:1; cf. 3:11-12; 10:17; 11:14; 12:15; 15:22, 32; 19:20; 27:5)

**Parents and children**—If you love your children, you will discipline them *Discipline your children, for in that there is hope; do not be a willing party to their death* (19:18; cf. 13:24; 15:5; 19:18; 22:6; 29:17)

**Self-control**—Don't overdo it, even with good things Whoever loves pleasure will become poor; whoever loves wine and olive oil will never be rich. (21:17; cf. 15:16; 23:1-3, 4, 20-21, 29-35; 25:16-17, 27, 28; 29:11)

**Work/Laziness**—Don't be lazy but work hard *Lazy hands make for poverty, but diligent hands bring wealth.* (10:4; cf. 6:6-11; 12:11, 14, 23; 19:15; 20:13; 24:30-34; 28:19

**Giving**—the Lord will reward those who give to the poor Whoever oppresses the **poor** shows contempt for their Maker, but whoever is kind to the needy honors God (14:31; cf. 11:24; 19:17; 21:13, 25-26; 22:9; 25:21; 28:27; 29:7, 14; 31:9; 31:20)

**Friends**—choose friends carefully, a good one is extremely valuable A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for a time of adversity (17:17; cf. 12:26; 18:24; 19:4, 6; 22:24; 27:6, 9)

**Talking, Gossip**—guard your tongue and don't be or associate with someone who talks too much

Fools find no pleasure in understanding, but delight in airing their own opinions (18:2; cf. 4:24; 8:8; 10:8; 11:12, 13; 12:18; 13:3; 15:26, 28; 16:24; 17:27; 20:19; 26:20)

**Conflict/Strife/Quarreling**—It is foolish to stir up a quarrel *The last item in the list of things the Lord hates is: a person who stirs up conflict in the community (6:16, 19; cf. 6:12-14, 10:12; 13:10; 15:18; 16:28; 17:14, 19; 20:3; 26:21; 29:22; 30:33)* 

**Forgiveness**—It is good to overlook or drop a matter *Fools show their annoyance at once, but the prudent overlook an insult* (12:16; cf. 10:12; 17:9; 19:11)

**Pride/Humility**—pride leads to ruin and humility leads to blessing *Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall* (16:18; cf. 8:13; 11:2; 13:10; 15:33; 16:5, 18, 19; 18:12; 21:4, 24; 22:4; 29:23)
