Thoughts from a Shepherd

For many of us the COVID pandemic has given us opportunities to do some things that we probably would not have done. I hope that you have spent some time considering your spiritual health. When we stopped in-person services, what did you miss most? As we have implemented services and classes in different formats and using different safety protocols, have the changes affected your perspective of how we have or should worship? Do you feel there is something missing or have you changed your spiritual activities to fill any voids? Paul in a letter to Timothy states “He [God] has saved us and called us to a holy life—not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time (2 Tim 1:90).” Through God’s providence, we are making progress against COVID. As we move forward, we need to help each other and those around us to recognize that God is in control of all situations. We need to Rise Up and live the life we have been called through His grace and for his purpose.
