Thoughts from a Shepherd

The Dictionary.com defines “listen” as a verb meaning: 1. to give attention with the ear; attend closely for the purpose of hearing; give ear, 2. to pay attention; heed; obey, 3. to wait attentively for a sound, and 4. to convey a particular impression to the hearer (informal definition). It is interesting to note in the three “formal” definitions listening always involves “attention or being attentive.” Truly listening to someone or to something means I have to be intentional, to be purposeful and to respect/honor the person speaking/ How often do we say, “Oh, I was just not listening,” “I listen to the music, but not the words,” “I heard you, but I was not listening,” etc.

These phrases indicate we just heard “noise” and did not actually pay attention as to what was said/conveyed. In essence we ignored the person talking or the words they were conveying. We did not value them or give them the honor/respect they deserve. Listening involves me having focus, intentionality, and purpose.

This month Brandyn and Casey have guided us through a series of lessons concerning “stopping and listening to God.” As they have shown us Scripture is filled with calls, declarations and pleas from God to listen and hear Him through His words and deeds. In some sense this is perhaps the overarching request of God - to listen to Him! The questions we need to ask of ourselves daily are: Why I should listen to Him? How can I listen to Him? When should I listen to Him? Where should I listen to Him? What do I do with what He tells me through Scripture, through His Spirit, through His Creation, the voices of His people? If we are not asking these questions and seeking answers, then we are not listening. We are just hearing the noise around us - just the music and not the lyrics.

My encouragement to you this week is to grapple with the aforementioned questions. And, I know this is strange, but to also ask them from the negative point of view: Why do I not want or not motivated to listen to God? What keeps me from listening to Him? What do I have to give up in order to Stop and Listen? These are all sobering questions, but we need to work through them so we may grow and be refined into what and whom God has called us to be. Many years ago there was a preacher in our heritage who had a weekly radio program in which he would share the Word with others and he would use a Mnemonic “hook” as his signature communication device to get the listeners’ attention. The phrase was, “Are you listening?” So, this is my question to you this week, “Are you listening?”
