## Thoughts from a Shepherd

#### How Patient Are We?

"Patience is a virtue" is a theme or moto that most of us have heard all of our lives. Yet, how many of us are really patient in the way we live our lives? Most of us are constantly on the move, in a hurry, and anything or anyone who causes us to be "late" or off schedule is minimally an annoyance or worse. Not a lot of patience is exhibited in times like that.

Paul talks about the importance of patience or perseverance (depending on your English translation of the New Testament) in Romans 5:3-4. Patience helps build character and hope. How do you react when you are driving and someone cuts you off? How do you react when a door is slammed in your face? How do you react when a brother or sister has a different view or understanding of a Biblical passage than we do? How patient are we with our Christian brother if they do not think the same way that we do on traditions, what we should be doing, etc.? A classical Biblical case is Job and his "friends" and their advice to him when his world crashed down around him.

Patience is a Christian virtue that we all need to continuously work on. Patience is not self-centered, it is God centered.

# Mission Sunday


