Thoughts from a Shepherd

This week I reread one of my favorite passages. It had been too long. Although I refer to it and quote parts of it frequently in conversation, I hadn't reexamined it recently. Sixty years ago that passage changed my life, several years after my own baptism. It changed my Christian focus from trying to avoid sin on my own effort to the biblical model of being "dead to sin" and "alive in Christ." What a relief and how empowering it was! Yeah, I still sinned and do so today. But, the Spirit empowers me to live a positive life, to have already made decisions consistent with God's character about many temptations. Do I still fail? Of course. Are failures debilitating and discouraging—not so much anymore. I am (and you are) alive in Christ. Hear Romans 6:3-4.

“Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ raise from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.”

If you have been baptized into Christ, do you realize you were raised to live a new life? Read all of Romans 6 again if you haven't lately. It's refreshing! If you haven't responded in faith to Christ through baptism, you are missing everything!

The children already downstairs will simply transition straight into bible classes at 10:30AM. Children 3rd-5th grades will transition from auditorium to bible class at the end of worship.
