## **COVID Update**

Some of our church family have recently been exposed to COVID-19. Five have contracted the infection. As of today, all five are recovering and following quarantine guidelines, along with their families. By the way, if you see Casey and Ashley Lankford out and about in a week or so, be assured they are recovered and safe to be around. For now, they are still symptomatic and recovering at home.

We are not changing any guidelines for attendance at in person church activities at this time, but thought it would be helpful to refresh our memories.

- 1. If exposed to an infected person, you must quarantine. A negative test not earlier than the 5th day after exposure will allow you to return to church activities after the 7th day, or you may be quarantined for 14 days without a test. This assumes the exposed person does not show any symptoms of COVID-19.
- 2. For church activities, if you become sick, please stay away until the 7th day after symptoms are gone. This could be more stringent than the CDC guidelines, but it is consistent with them.
- 3. If you feel sick, please do not come to church activities in person (most important).
- 4. We will continue to have a "mask required" section in the auditorium (next to the baptistery). Masks are optional elsewhere.

Your leadership team is reviewing our situation almost daily, and we discuss it each weekly meeting. If you have concerns or questions, please ask one of the elders.

To limit exposure times, we are also reemphasizing limiting worship and classes to 45 minutes each.
