

We also greatly appreciate the many volunteers who helped with projects. As our 30 plus year old building ages, we frequently have "surprises" of needed repairs throughout the year.

This year we plan to replace the deteriorating flooring in downstairs children's hallway of the education building, install additional drain spouts from the roof to eliminate pooling on the roof, and install a family picnic area in the lower field. We also plan to add to our benevolent funds, and create a contingency fund for both benevolence and the building emergencies. This year's goal is <u>\$65,000</u>.
