Repair roof over porches and drive through	Leaking
Repair or cap the old well	Edwards Aquifer Authority will start fining the church
Replace flooring in offices	Over 30 years old and well worn
Replace flooring in Children's hallway	Worn and damaged
Replace refrigerators in kitchen	Current refrigerators rusted and leaking
Replace microphones for auditorium	Starting to fail

Children's Giving



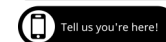
