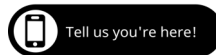

Come by the Christmas tree in the main foyer and pick up your Angel Tree tag. We only have a few left.

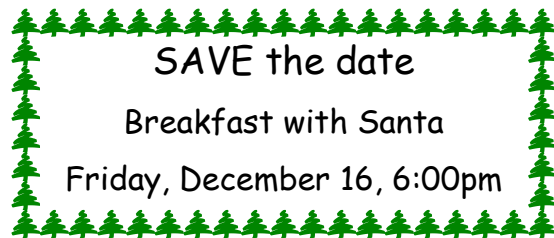
You will see there are two tags together. Take the first one, sign the back one and leave on the tree.
