The Passover Festival—Reliving Jesus' Last Supper

On Good Friday evening, April 7, we will reenact Jesus' last supper with his disciples. This is not the traditional Jewish Passover seder observed today, but a recreation of a Passover meal much like the one Jesus and His disciples celebrated the night before His death. Passover is for everyone—young and old, families and singles, friends and neighbors—and children are an important part of the festival.

The Passover feast is a time of thanksgiving to God for saving His people from slavery in Egypt and a time to pass on the faith to the next generation. The festival includes the *Haggadah* (the retelling of the Passover story) and the *Hallel* (songs of praise and thanksgiving). We will eat samples of the Passover meal of roast lamb, unleavened bread, "bitter herbs," and more. And we will reenact the beginning of the Lord's Supper. This will be an evening to remember.
